- 1. Cd player
- 2. CDs (I suggest purchasing some music with no lyrics. My favorites are classical and movie soundtracks.)
- 3. Stools (2 to 4)
- 4. Wooden Boxes (4 to 6) great for scene work
- 5. Rug (if classroom isn't carpeted)
- 6. Posters of Broadway musicals and plays (posted on walls around the classroom)
- 7. Large box of sound effects (small drum, bell, whistle, rain stick, vibraslap, flexetone, child's zylophone, etc.)
- 8. Masks (I placed them on the upper part of the walls of my classroom)
- 9. Large box of various costume pieces (hats, gloves, cape, towel, wigs)
- 10. A reading corner with books about theatre, acting, scripts
- 11. Rubber ball (medium size)
- 12. Large box of props (cane, rubber chicken, baby doll, mixing bowl, wooden spoon, material of various sizes and colors)
- 13. Handbills from plays and musicals (posted on walls)
